

**Transcript of School Register from Chestnut Hall (Chestnut Grove)
One-Room School
Harmony Township, Morrow County, Ohio
Covering Various School Terms from 1878 to 1885**

Transcript Prepared in April 2003

This is a transcript of a teacher's attendance and school term record book from Chestnut Hall School, which was located on what is now County Road 114 in Harmony Township, Morrow County, Ohio, between County Roads 124 and 23. The school was situated on the east side of the road on a knoll north of the northernmost of the two creeks that cross that segment of the road. The school was in the west part of Lot 7, Township 7-North, Range 16-West, Quarter 2, of U.S. Military Lands.

Physical Description of the School Register

The document is a hardbound volume 8-1/2 inches wide by 13-1/2 inches high with maroon pattern covers, a stitched binding, and cloth tape over the spine. An adhesive label on the center of the outside front cover is imprinted

Imprinting on the inside front cover identifies the volume as part of the "Eclectic Educational Series" published by Van Antwerp, Bragg & Co., successors to Wilson, Hinkle & Co., of 137 Walnut Street, Cincinnati, Ohio; and 28 Bond Street, New York. The volume was prepared by E.E. White, A.M., Ex-Commissioner of Common Schools of Ohio. There is no copyright date or date of publication or sale per se, but a legend at the bottom of page 1 reads: "Entered, according to Act of Congress, in the year 1869, by Wilson, Hinkle & Co., in the Clerk's Office of the District Court of the United States, for the Southern District of Ohio."

The body of the book is a series of unnumbered, preprinted ledger or register forms, filled in by hand in ink and pencil, with symbols to denote days present and absent among other information. The main body of the book is divided into two sections, with the first 35 pages devoted to forms for daily attendance records (generally two facing pages per term), and pages 36 through 48 devoted to term summary records (one page per term).

The inside front cover, page 50, and the inside back cover are imprinted with advertisements of other books and products from the publisher. Page 49 contains instructions for teachers to use in filling in the book. Pages 34, 35, 42, 46, and 47 are imprinted with grids or forms, but have no handwritten entries. The leaves containing pages 41 and 42 and pages 47 and 48 are torn and partly missing.

Nature of the Transcript

The following transcript, prepared in 2003, was prepared by Vincent J. Brown of Harmony Township (born 1959). The original book is believed to have been given to him in the 1970s by his paternal grandmother, Hazel Loree (Chilcote) Brown, a lifelong resident of Harmony Township. In the transcript, the [?] symbol denotes unclear original. Other information enclosed in square brackets [] in this transcript, such as a letter, date, or line number, was added during the transcription. If student number or line number appears without square brackets, then that means the numbers were written by the teacher in the original manuscript. Underlined information in the page headings in this transcript also represents handwritten entries. Spellings and the order of lines or entries are generally as given in the original handwriting. Obvious errors in the manuscript, such as switching the first and last names, have been silently corrected in this transcript.

On most pages, the students were separated by gender, and the names were listed alphabetically within the boys' and girls' lists. Exceptions were evidently made for late enrollments.

All information in the "Comments" column was provided by the transcriptionist. Comments relating to attendance (for example, "Absent 2nd half") are somewhat subjective, based on general patterns of attendance and absence. These comments are intended to give greater precision beyond what is contained in the teacher's numerical totals of each student's days present and days absent.

Other comments refer to probable name corrections. To be faithful to the original, the names are transcribed verbatim, but when comparing similar names across terms (see appendix), certain forms of each name appeared to be preferable or more prevalent. When the best form of a name is not known, the most likely alternates are shown in the comments column. One benefit of having daily and term records combined in a single volume is that many rosters are recorded twice, permitting cross-checking of spellings or handwriting that is difficult to interpret.

Summary of Information in the Transcript

The standard school term at Chestnut Hall from 1878 to 1885 was approximately 72 days. The first term usually began around Thanksgiving and ran until early March. The second term usually began in early May and ran until early August. In the daily and term records, the numbers of days present and absent do not always total the full number of days in the term, presumably because of late enrollments and withdrawals at mid-term.

The daily records were consistently kept in this school register from December 1878 to March of 1885, for a period of 13 school terms. By contrast, the term records are predominantly for the spring terms, with only two of the eight term records being for the fall/winter term. The reason that most of the fall/winter terms were not recorded on the term summary pages is not known.

The table below shows the school terms for which daily and/or term records appear in the book, the original page number (top left of the page, in square brackets) and the transcript page number (bottom right of the page, in the running footer) on which these records appear. Accounting for

variations in spelling of first and last names, there are approximately 190 unique names in the book, including students and teachers (see index in the appendix of this transcript).

The table also shows the approximate enrollment in each term. The average enrollment through the 13 school terms was approximately 27 students, with a minimum enrollment of 18 and a maximum of 38.

Notable Students and Teachers

Ettie (or Ellie) Thomas and Gideon Sipe are the oldest students named in the book, with an estimated birth year of 1860. These two students, plus Jennie Thornburg, attended Chestnut Hall at 19 years of age. The age of 19 is the highest age recorded for any student, regardless of birth year.

Bessie Brown was the youngest student named in the book, having been born in 1787, and having attended the school at age 6. A number of other students, who were born in earlier years, attended the school at age 5, which is the youngest age recorded regardless of birth year.

The male students having ages listed in the daily records averaged 11.6 years of age. The female students averaged 10.2 years of age.

Of the ten teachers named in the record book, looking across all 13 school terms, only two teachers taught more than one term. Ollie McCracken taught the spring terms in 1879 and 1880, and Alice M. King taught the spring terms in 1881 and 1883.

[Transcriptionist's note: Pages 41 through 43 are curious, because it appears that Mr. Sipe tore out a vertically rectangular piece of the leaf containing pages 41 and 42. The missing portion is away from the binding and is approximately 4 inches wide by 11 inches high. The torn portion appears to have been made to allow Mr. Sipe to put his "General Summary" information on the following recto page now visible through the tear, page 43. Because of the torn portion, when the book is open to pages 40-41, the reader can actually see the Pupils' Names as written on page 41 and the General Summary on page 43 at the same time.

The ink and handwriting in the General Summary of page 43 match that of the "Pupils' Names" on page 41. It may be that Mr. Sipe wrote his General Summary on page 41 and then decided to revise it, or that the portion of the page was damaged or defaced. The tear in the leaf containing pages 41 and 42 appears to have been made carefully and deliberately.

No handwriting is visible on the remaining area of the torn verso page 42. The curiosity is compounded by the top heading section of page 43 being filled in, in a different handwriting and ink, as follows:

"Term Record of Chestnut Hall School for the Term commencing April 28th, 1884, and ending August 2nd, 1884, [Second] Term of School Year, Jennie Mateer, Teacher."

This same heading information is then essentially repeated on the following verso, page 44.

The most plausible explanation is that Mr. Sipe, in preparing his Term Record in February 1884, made some major error or some accident befell the General Summary, and so he decided to avoid the labor of recopying all of the pupil information on a new leaf. His shortcut was to tear a corner "window" in the page, and complete his General Summary using page 43.

Continuing in this speculation, in August of 1884, Miss Mateer probably began her Term Record on the next available full page after the torn leaf, that is, page 43, but having filled in the heading information, she discovered that Mr. Sipe had already used the General Summary section on that page, so she turned to the next page (page 44), filled in the same heading information as she had done on page 43, and completed her Term Record.]

Appendix:

Alphabetical Index of All Names in the School Register

The table below shows the corrected names of the students and teachers appearing in the Chestnut Hall school record book from 1878 to 1885. Some names (especially last names) were corrected based on the prevalence of some spelling forms over others. Notes on all corrections are included in the “Comments” column of the transcript pages above.

Gender and age are as shown on the original records. Age will vary depending on the student’s age during the term being recorded on a given page. Birth years were estimated by subtracting the age from the year that the term began; thus, a single student may have 1, 2, or even 3 estimated birth years. No attempt has been to verify the birth years versus any external records or documents.

The “T” in the Teacher column indicates that the name is a teacher’s. The original page numbers refer to the pagination of the school record book, as shown at the top left of the transcript pages, and not to the pagination of this transcript, shown in the running footer. The line numbers refer to either the numbering used by the teacher (which sometimes restarted with the boys’ and girls’ lists on a single page), or the line numbering used as a convenience in the transcription process.

Values of “N/A” mean either that the information was missing in the original or could not confidently be determined, for example, the gender of a teacher who gave initials instead of a full first name.
