Each claim made about your ancestor must be proven. Each proving document you submit should be identified by giving it a letter (A,B,C, etc.) and clearly writing its identifying letter on the front. DO NOT SUBMIT ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS. Copies of documents may be (1) photo or other facsimiles of the originals or (2) exact typed or hand printed copies of the original certified as true copies by a courthouse official, genealogical librarian or other official. The source of each document should be indicated on the front.

Fill out the chart. At the end of each line put the number of the footnote line (below) on which you cite the document (including their identifying letters) which prove the claim to be true. For example, suppose you claim that Jane Roe died on 7 May 1847. On a blank footnote line cite the document which shows that this is so and write the number of the footnote line on the appropriate line. (Example: The said Jane Roe died on 7 May 1847 at Athens County, Ohio..Footnote line 7. Death Certificate – document F.
