MORROW'S MULTILPLE MAILING MYSTERY

Many people are surprised to learn that present-day residents of Morrow County can receive their mail from one of TWENTY post offices! The following nine offices are located within the boundaries of the county:

GERMAN MIGRATION RESEARCH SERVICE

Now it is easier to confirm the date and place of origin of ancestors from Germany. The Museum for Hamburg History has established a Historic Emigration Office (HEO). For \$30 (paid by certified check) a clerk will search for one ancestor from 274 microfilm files containing nearly 5 million names. This cost is valid if you can supply the correct migration year; there is a charge of \$10 more for each additional year that must be searched. In the files are the names of each passenger, his age,

occupation, family, and home city, as recorded by the ship's agent. HOWEVER, these records are only for emigrants who embarked from the City of Hamburg, and only during the years from 1850 to 1914.

AFFIDAVITS OF ALIENS INTENTIONS -- MORROW COUNTY, OHIO VOLUME I == 1855 - 1859

Formerly a docket kept by the Clerk of the Common Pleas Court, W. W. IRWIN, this book was placed on the disposal list by the County Records Committee. Custody was then given to the Morrow County Historical Society, and so this book is now in the Pleasant Grove Museum. The affidavit reads as follows:

STORIES IN STONE

While in the process of transcribing tombstone inscriptions from the cemeteries of Morrow County, our society members have discovered some examples of markers that contain more than the essential names and dates:

"ELIZABETH, wife of James Auten Born Oct 4, 1800 Died Nov 25, 1871 Aged 7lyr. 21 ds. Daughter of David Enochs, Married Aug 21, 1821, and moved to Ohio near Galion; Family of 8 children, 4 boys and 4 girls -lived to see them all married." [Auten Cemetery, Washington township]

"John S. McKibben, Private in Co. O, 65 Reg O.V.I. Wounded at Resacca, Ga. May 11, 1864. Died while returning home furlow in company of his father in the Soldiers Home Cincinnati, Ohio, July 18, 1864, aged 23 yrs. 1 mo. & 19 ds."

"HENRY TENNANT, born near Johnsville, O. May 7, 1882. Died at the home of his parents in Columbus, O., December 23, 1907, Aged 25 yrs. 7 mos. 16 ds.

Prodigal Son-He Fell Among Thieves.

Death Bed Repentance--Testimony With Up Lifted, Beckoning Hands. The Lord, The Lord, He Is A Good Lord, I Am A Redeemed Man, I Am A Happy Man, And Sang With Smiling Countenance Full Of Rapture And Evidences of Supernatural Power To Those Who Witnessed The Scene. The Good Samaritan Journeyed Where He Was And Had Compassion On Him And Bound Up His Wounds."

DECLARATION OF ALIENS -- PROBATE COURT OF MORROW COUNTY, OHIO

1859 -- 1879

(This record is located in the Probate Court Office of the Court House in Mount Gilead. Even though this record has a different title and originated in a different county office, it appears that this is a continuation of the "Affidavits of Aliens Intentions". The texts of the journal record are identical, except that these Declarations were sworn before the Probate Judge. The judges' names and terms:
