PUBLICATION SALES UPDATE

As of 15 February 1987 there were approximately 25 copies remaining of our first publication, MORROW COUNTY, OHIO -- TOMBSTONE INSCRIPTIONS (Volume 1: Perry and Troy Townships). This was from a total of 150 copies printed in March of 1986. In addition to sales to individuals, several libraries and historical societies around the country have purchased books:

Allen Co. Public Library, Ft. Wayne, IN; Wisconsin State Historical Society; Genealogical Society of Salt Lake City; Licking Co. Genealogical Society; State Library of Ohio; Western Reserve Historical Society; Cincinnati Public Library; Ohio Historical Society; Dallas Public Library.

The 86-page paperback book lists the inscriptions from seven cemeteries in Perry Township and from six cemeteries in Troy. The cost is \$6.00 per copy (which includes postage & handling). Ohio residents must add 33¢ sales tax.
