STATE RAISES COST OF OBTAINING RECORDS

The Ohio General Assembly increased the cost of certified copies of birth & death certificates to \$5.00 each, effective 26 December 1984, and applicable to both state and local levels. The Ohio Department of Health, Division of Vital Statistics has maintained records of births and deaths for the entire state since 20 December 1908. Certificates may be obtained by mail: specify the person's name, date of event (birth or death), and place of event (county, city or village, township); send check or money order payable to "Div. of Vital Statistics" to Ohio Department of Health, Room G-20, Ohio Departments Building, Columbus, OH 43215. If the exact year is not known the staff charges a fee of \$3.00 for a search of each span of ten years. An alternative to the higher cost is to request uncertified copies. These are \$3.10 each and are stamped "Statistical Use Only".

COMING IN APRIL --- MEMBERS SURNAME DIRECTORY:

Our April <u>Newsletter</u> will feature a members Directory of Surnames. This will be our first since 1976. All members are invited to participate by submitting a list of their known ancestral families to the Newsletter editor. Or you may send copies of pedigree charts, from which the list of surnames will be extracted. These names do not have to be limited to Morrow County or Ohio only. All members, past and present, are eligible to be included, but only those with their 1985 dues paid will receive copies of the directory. Deadline for submission of surnames is April 1st.

Dues are \$5.00 a year for one person, or \$7.00 for a joint membership.

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SOLDIERS OF THE REVOLUTION -- BURIED IN MORROW COUNTY, OHIO

This list was obtained from the Veterans Grave Registration file in the Morrow County Recorder's office, the WPA - American Legion cemetery maps, and other sources. It is not meant to be a definitive list of fighters for Independence reposing in Morrow sod. The data is incomplete, the sources sometimes conflicting, and this list remains open for debate and further research. Some of these men were also identified as veterans of the War of 1812.
