1910 CENSUS DONATION

The 1910 FEDERAL CENSUS OF MORROW COUNTY has now been added to our collection,
 donated by member Ruth Hocker. This completes all available decennial census
 records for our county. Our next goal is to accumulate the microfilms for the "par-
 ent counties" of Morrow for the years 1820, 1830 and 1840. [We already have Knox
 County census of 1820, 1830, 1840 & 1850.] Each roll of microfilm costs \$11.00,

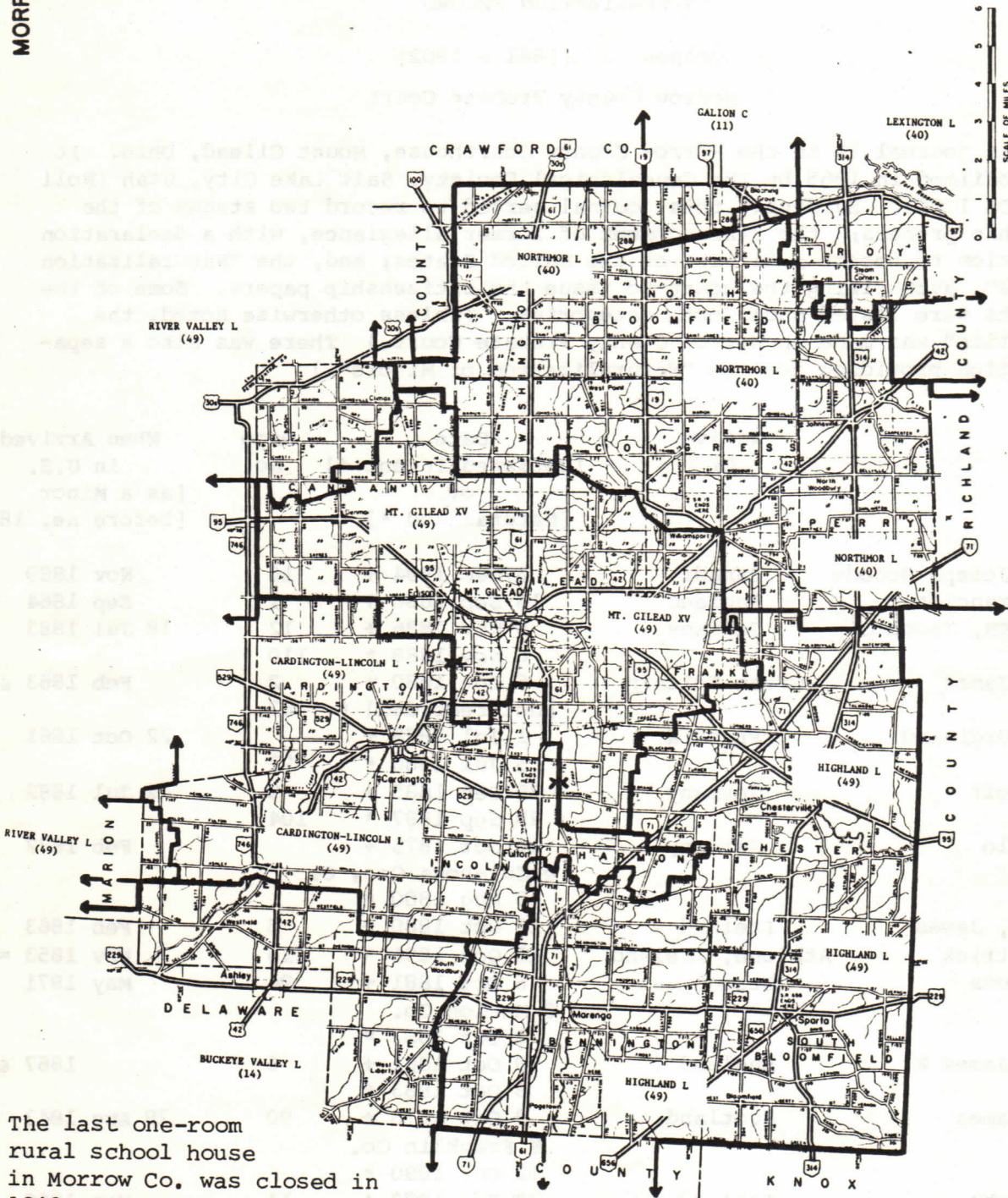

The last one-room rural school house in Morrow Co. was closed in 1940. Over the years consolidation has reduced the number of county-based school districts to four:

- CARDINGTON-LINCOLN Local
- HIGHLAND Local
- NORTHMOR Local
- MOUNT GILEAD Exempted Village

As the map shows, there are also four other districts which serve Morrow County residents:

- BUCKEYE VALLEY Local
- GALION City
- LEXINGTON Local
- RIVER VALLEY Local

NATURALIZATION RECORD

Volume 2 (1861 - 1902)

Morrow County Probate Court

[This journal is in the Morrow County Courthouse, Mount Gilead, Ohio. It was microfilmed in 1965 by The Genealogical Society, Salt Lake City, Utah (Roll Number VDS 1080). Evidently this journal served to record two stages of the citizenship process: the renouncement of former allegiance, with a declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States; and, the "Naturalization of Aliens", authorizing the court to issue the citizenship papers. Some of the immigrants were listed under both categories. (Unless otherwise noted, the "Declaration" was made in Morrow County Probate Court.) There was also a separate section providing for the "Naturalization of Minors".]
