We are proud to announce the arrival of LEVI DANIEL RHODEBECK, son of Daniel & Janet Rhodebeck, Morrow County Genealogical Society members. He was born Saturday the 19th of November, 1988 at 2:02 p.m. in Morrow County Hospital, Mount Gilead.

Levi's grandmother, Mary Murphy, and his aunt and uncle, Karen and Jeff Sigsworth, are also members of M.C.G.S.

His weight was seven pounds, seven ounces, and measured 20 inches. He was named after his maternal great grandfather, Levi Henry.

S O L D I E R S M O N U M E N T
CARDINGTON, OHIO

In addition to the Victory Shaft in the middle of the Public Square in Mount Gilead (which commemorates Morrow County's contributions during World War I), there is an older memorial in the county, honoring a community's contribution to the Union cause in the Civil War. The SOLDIERS MONUMENT in Glendale Cemetery, Cardington, was dedicated on the 4th of July, 1889. Constructed of bronze, its base consists of four rectangular sides (each 7.5 feet wide) forming a pedestal on which stands the statue of a soldier.

The soldier is a private, with arms at parade rest, facing towards the south (the direction to which he marched). Total height is 22 feet.

The Cardington Veterans Association ordered the structure from a monument company in Bridgeport, CT, for \$2500. Mr. Lewis Slack, of Ashley, Ohio, was the agent for the company in Morrow County. It has the names of 296 veterans, on all 4 sides of the base.

On the north side is a large emblem of the G.A.R., and on the south:

Their Heroic Defenders of the
Union, 1861 - 1865.

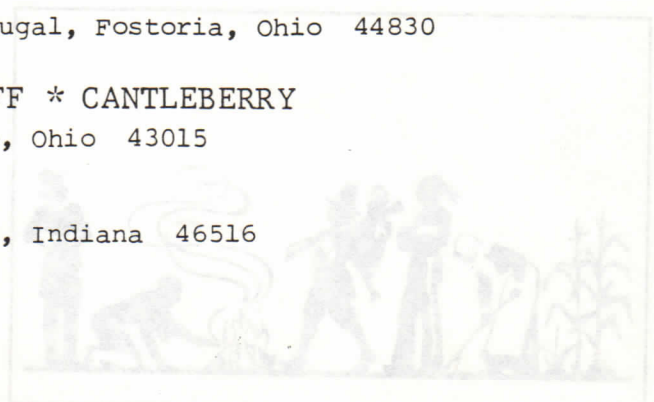
