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MORROW COUNTY, OHIO

Morrow County, Ohio was formed in 1848 from parts of four existing counties:

Delaware, Knox, Marion & Richland.

All records in the Court House in Mount Gilead have been created since that year of formation. Therefore, for any research prior to 1848, the exact location of the subject's residence must be known in order to determine which county had jurisdiction over that specific site.

The Morrow County Court House is at 48 East High Street, and is open Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The MORROW COUNTY GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY was organized in 1976, and received its charter as a Chapter of The Ohio Genealogical Society in 1977.

Annual Membership dues are \$5.00 per person; or \$7.00 for a Joint Membership (two persons at one address).

The M. C. G. S. publishes a quarterly newsletter, entitled THE MONUMENT, which is included with each membership.

LIBRARY: An agreement has been made with the Mount Gilead Free Public Library to reserve space for the Society's collection of materials. The Library, located at 35 East High Street, is conveniently situated across the street from the Court House, and houses a growing inventory of books, family & county histories, and microfilm. The hours for the Public Library are:

Monday through Thursday == 12:30 to 8:30 p.m.
Friday == 12:30 to 7:00 p.m.
Saturday == 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

(The library staff does not handle requests for research, so all correspondence should be sent to the M.C.G.S. address listed below.)

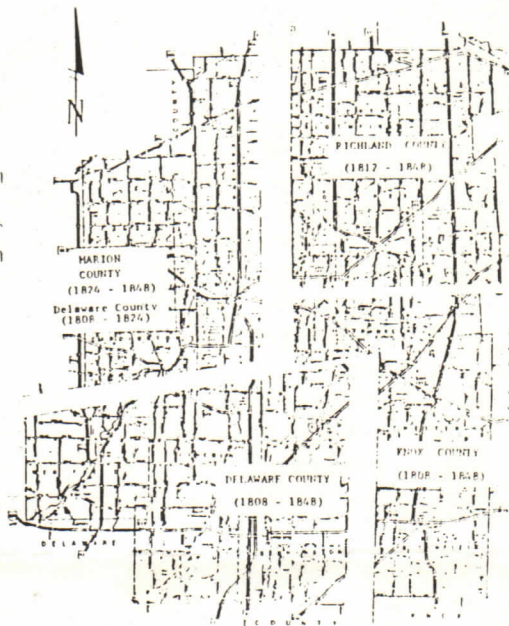
Most meetings of the Morrow County Genealogical Society are held in the basement meeting room of the First Federal Savings & Loan, 70 North Main Street, Mount Gilead. The regular dates are as follows:

January, February and March == Fourth Saturdays, at 2:00 p.m.

April, May, August, September, October and November == Fourth Monday of the month, at 7:30 p.m.

No meetings in June, July and December. (There are occasional exceptions to the above schedule, so it would be wise to consult the M.C.G.S. before planning to attend a meeting.)

An auxiliary to the Society is the First Families of Morrow County, which is open to anyone who can prove one or more ancestors as residents of the county (or its territory) prior to 1851. There is a one-time application fee: \$15.00 for M.C.G.S. members; \$20.00 for non-members. Qualified members receive a certificate and lapel pin.
