MARENGO CEMETERY ASSOCIATION

This small notebook $(7\frac{1}{2}" \times 6")$ was the first record of the Marengo Cemetery Association. Not a record of burials, rather it is an account of the minutes of the meetings of the board and the first sale of lots. Only the first 22 pages of its total of 108 pages were used, covering various meetings in 1859, 1862, 1872, 1877, 1878, 1879 and 1889. This book was loaned to us by John D. Pennington, Clerk of Bennington Township. Further inquiry can be addressed to P.O. Box 221, Marengo, Ohio 43334. (Only the first paragraph below is a quotation; the rest are excerpts.)

ORGANIZATION

We the undersigned residents of the County of Morrow, State of Ohio, hereby associate together for Burial purposes, under the name of the "Marengo Cemetry [sic] Association" as provided by the act of the Legislature passed February 24th A.D. 1848. Witness our hands this 13th day of August 1859.

DEED AND SURVEY

Part of the Southeast part of Lot 11, Section 2 Township 6 Range 16 of U.S. Military Lands, containing 168 perches, purchased from Robert Noe and wife Mary Noe, for \$160.00 on September 2, 1859. [Recorded in Volume 12, page 564 by Silas Holt, Recorder] Surveyed along the Mt. Vernon and Norton Road by J. T. Buck, Deputy County Surveyor (Thos. Sharp being the County Surveyor), and divided into 100 numbered burial lots, each being 12 feet wide and 17 feet long, with a "Public Burial Ground" on the east side 40 feet wide (not surveyed into individual lots). [A fold-out map was pasted inside the front cover of the book.] The appraised value of the lots ranged from \$2.00 to \$6.00 each, in one dollar increments. At a public sale held August 27, 1859, there were 21 lots sold, at prices from \$3.00 to \$10.00 each.
