**NORTH BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP 'POLL BOOK' \*\* 1850**

[The original document furnishing these names was recently donated to the Ohio Genealogical Society Library manuscript collection by Mary Jane Henney, of Mansfield. It apparently came from a package of miscellaneous papers in the Richland County Clerk of Courts office. Our listing presented here was taken from a faint photocopy provided by Thomas Stephen Neel, O.G.S. office manager. Several of the names in this hand-written list were especially hard to decipher, and were subject to speculation as to spelling.]

"Poll Book of the Election held in the Township of North Bloomfield in the County of Morrow on the Eighth Day of October A.D. Eighteen Hundred and fifty. John Graham, Andrew Mitchell and Wm. Henderson, Judges. Milton Reeder and Wm. Wallace Clerks of said Election were severally sworn as the Law directs previous to their Entering on the Duties of their respective offices."

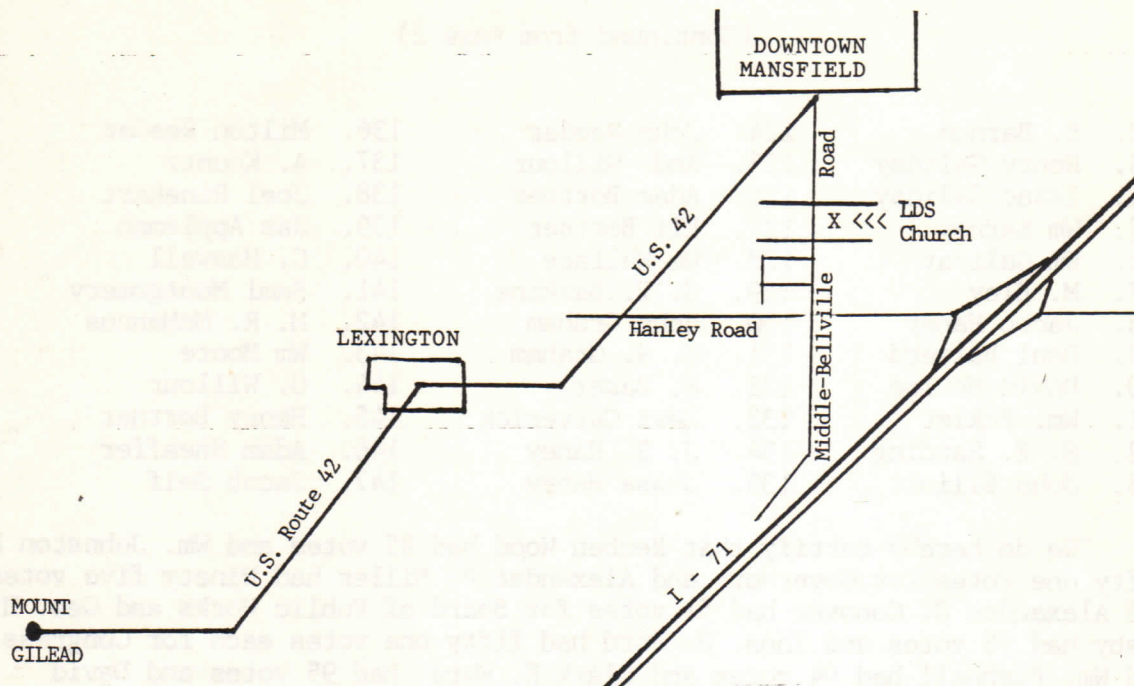

FAMILY HISTORY CENTER, Mansfield, Ohio -- April 27, 1991



On Saturday April 27th the Morrow County Genealogical Society will conduct its monthly meeting and program about 24 miles from Mount Gilead. Special arrangements have been made to visit the Family History Center in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, 1951 Middle-Bellville Road, Mansfield, Ohio. (Regular hours to use this Phase III Mormon branch library are 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Tuesdays; 1 to 5 and 6 to 9 p.m. on Wednesdays; and 6 to 9 p.m. on Sundays.) The church is located  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile north of Hanley Road, or  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles south of the junction of U.S. Route 42 (Lexington Avenue) and Middle-Bellville Road. Patrons of the library can consult the 1.5 million reels of microfilm which can be borrowed from Salt Lake City, and use FamilySearch and AncestralFile programs on the Center's computer.

A car caravan will be leaving the parking lot of the First Federal Savings and Loan in Mount Gilead at 1:00 p.m. sharp on the 27th for those who wish to share rides or to have help finding the church.
