

ORIGINAL LAND OWNERS --- New Guidebook Available

Researchers delving into the earliest years of Morrow County's history are often interested in the original acquisition of land. To help facilitate this search, a notebook has been assembled for our library. It combines the work of two persons who have diligently extracted the information. The titles are:

ORIGINAL PURCHASERS OF LAND IN RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO, by Ellsworth H. Morse, Jr. (1966 & 1970) [The pages which cover the townships of Perry, Troy, North Bloomfield, Congress, and a small portion of Gilead, as well as the introductory material were photocopied from the original book in the Ohio Genealogical Society library.]

OHIO LANDS: CHILLICOTHE LAND OFFICE, 1800--1829, by Marie Taylor Clark, C.G. (1984) [This book has been in our library for some time, but the references to those Morrow County townships which lie south of the Greenville Treaty Line may not have been easily found. This was known as the "United States Military Tract".]

Two interesting entries in this latter book are found on page 112. An entire township, described as Range 15 Township 7 (later known as "Chester Township") was deeded to David Jones on 5 March 1805. That comprised 4,000 acres. And a notation was found referring to Range 15, Township 6 (later to be called "South Bloomfield Township"):

CENTRE OF THE STATE OF OHIO. AGREEABLE TO THE CALCULATION MADE BY THE CONGRESS APPRIATED BY THE LEGISLATURE FOR FIXING THE PERMANENT SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.
