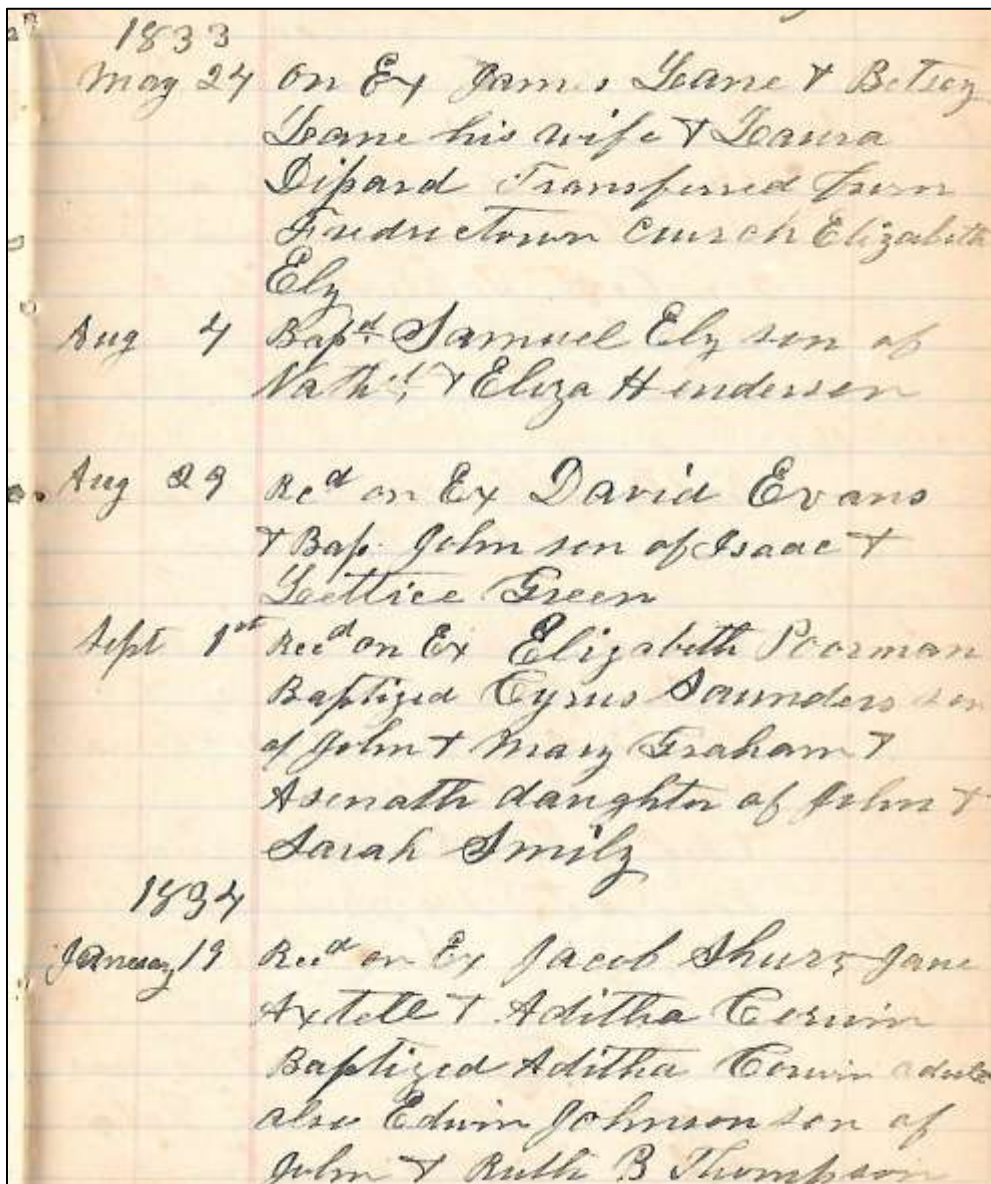


# Transcript of Old Harmony Presbyterian Church Record Book

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## Introduction

In 2024, Dennis Siegfried posted on social media about an old record book in his possession, purporting to document the membership history of Old Harmony Presbyterian Church. This congregation is believed to have been based in the vicinity of the intersection of present Ohio Route 314 and Morrow County Road 14 in eastern Franklin Township, Morrow County, in North Central Ohio. According to the FindAGrave website, the GIS/GPS coordinates are

My smart phone map gives the coordinates as: 40°31'9" N 82°40'5" W 1240 ft elevation

A cemetery is at the site today. According to the Old Harmony record book, the congregation flourished between the mid-1820s and the mid-1840s, but some sources say the church continued in operation until 1864. One mystery is the relationship, if any, between Old Harmony Presbyterian Church/Cemetery and Yankee Street Presbyterian Church/Cemetery. Records for Yankee Street are scarce, but the cemetery on the site is now named for the latter church. Some sources give the nickname "Pioneer" for this same cemetery.

## Organization of this Transcript

This report is an amateur transcript of the contents of Mr. Siegfried's record book, along with commentary, notes, and supporting information from other sources, with indexes. The transcript is based on a series of page scans or digital photographs, and is organized according to the file names assigned by Mr. Siegfried. The record book consists of three main sections:

- **Records**, consisting of a chronicle in date order from February 1825 to August 1846, describing main events in the congregation, such as new members received, members being dismissed, baptisms, church trials, appointments of elders and pastors, celebrations of the Lord's Supper, and other important happenings [10 files = 20 pages].
- **Membership**, beginning with a list of about 50 Old Harmony members who were dismissed to join with the Center Presbyterian Church in or near 1836; followed by a list of all members, their dates of joining Old Harmony, and, for some of the names, information on their dismissal, death, marriage, etc. [5 files = 10 pages]
- **Burials** in the Old Harmony (Yankee Street) Cemetery [1 file = 2 pages]

Each file is further subdivided into individual sides or pages/sheets in the original, either left-hand or verso pages and right-hand or recto pages. The index in the back of this transcript (Appendix K) is keyed first to the file names, then to left or right side, and then to a sequence number that reflects the order of each name on that page or sheet, from top to bottom. Appendix J has a compact list of all unique surnames or last names for quick reference.

Those with access to the original artifact, which is a hardbound volume measuring about 8 inches high by 5 inches wide, should know that the the reading order is somewhat jumbled. Whoever inscribed the book evidently began in the middle of the book. There are no page numbers, and even if there were, they would not be helpful, as you will soon see. The "back half" of the book is written right-side-up relative to the front cover, starting with the dismissal and full membership lists, followed by the burials list near the back cover. To start reading the chronicle or "records" portion, the reader must turn the book upside-down and find the middle of the book. The earliest 1825 records begin there, and continue "forward" toward the 1846 records (still upside-down), near the front cover. [Aside: Would try to explain it better, but am getting a headache. You'll figure it out.]

Any counts in this transcript should be viewed with caution, because many names were repeated. It was seldom clear whether to lump similar or identical names together or split them. For example, there are many Mary Leverings/Laverings in the book, with no way to identify who was who. One was married to Charles, one to John, and one to Nathan. Or was one Mary widowed and took a second Levering husband? Likewise, one Mary joined Old Harmony on 8/24/1826 and another on 8/28/1826, and a third on 10/1/1829. It is impossible to know whether these were three women, or if one of them joined the church, left, and then rejoined it three years later. Similarly, there may be three "Elizabeth Millers" in this record, one with no suffix, and then an "Elizabeth Sr." and an "Elizabeth Jr."

The most common surnames in the record were:

- Shearer, Rev. F. A. 1846.

For most of these clergy, it is not known which were formally appointed and which may have been supply or visitors.

Not all of the names in this record book are marked as being members of the congregation. Some were named only as parents of baptized children, or spouses of recognized members. There is no way of knowing how complete or accurate these records are. Some cross-checking is possible looking across the list of members dismissed to Center Church, the separate list of all members, and the chronological list of all events, which includes the acceptance/confirmation of new members.

Nearly every new member record was duly noted as being either “by examination” or “by certificate” of transfer from some other church. Such records “by cert” typically name the session or congregation from which the new member came.<sup>1</sup> The practice of accepting members either by examination or by certificate continues to this day in Presbyterian churches.

### **Notable Events**

The church had a huge influx of members in its second year, growing from 19 members joining in 1825 to having 88 members by the end of 1826. The subsequent growth was steady and

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<sup>1</sup> According to Wikipedia, a “session” is a body of elected elders governing a particular church within Presbyterian polity. These groups of elders make decisions for the local parish through a ruling body called the Kirk session, sometimes the Session, church session, or consistory. The members of the session are the pastor (Teaching Elder) of that congregation, and the other ruling elders (sometimes called “lay elders”). Elders are ordained for life, so if they are subsequently elected or appointed to Sessions at later points in their lives, they are inducted, there being no second ordination. In most denominations, the pastor serves as Moderator of the Session and thus convenes or presides over the session. All elders have an equal vote in the session.

moderate for the next 12 years, with the church taking in at least 10 new members in nine of those years, between 1827 and 1838. Fewer new members joined after 1839, with no more than eight joining in any single year between then and the last record dated 1846.

The largest membership drop was in 1836, when 49 Old Harmony members were dismissed to Center Church, presumably related to a split in the church based on people's positions on the issue of slavery.

The record book lists three trials held before the Old Harmony session, namely those of

- David Moore for “unchristian conduct viz [namely] drunkenness & profane swearing” in August 1827. He was suspended “until evidence of true repentance.”
- Hannah Prouty for fornication in February 1834. She had joined Old Harmony in 1828. At trial, she refused to confess, so the session suspended her. This trial took place about 16 years before the publication of Nathaniel Hawthorne's novel *The Scarlet Letter*.
- Eli Graham for profanity in October 1837. The record shows that “he confessed his guilt but would not confess sorrow for it so the session suspended him.” The following March, 1838, he did profess repentance and was restored to church privileges.

Besides the mass departure or split in 1836, there is another suggestion of conflict in the church. In February 1841, a record reads that the “Session labored to reconcile Wm Pharis & others but did not succeed.” The following month, another record says, “Pharis case referred to Presbytery. Richard Struble to represent the church. Wm Rambo Alternate.” The nature of this case is not known.

As for the most fertile families, two couples, Joel and Jane Axtell and Nathan and Mary Levering each had seven children baptized at Old Harmony. Christopher Sipe Sr. and his wife Mary had six children baptized at the church. Appendix I lists the known or probable/assumed marriages and the parent-child relationships (based on baptisms) given in the record book. When three new members—a man and two women or girls with the same surname—join the church on the same day, it is tempting to assume that the man and the first woman are husband and wife, but there is no guarantee. Maybe the wife died and the father joined the church with two daughters.

### **Location of Old Harmony Presbyterian Church and Cemetery**

As noted above, the Old Harmony Presbyterian Church is believed to have stood in east central Franklin Township, along present Ohio Route 314, on a parcel of land covering between 1 and 2 acres straddling the Greenville Treaty Line (GTL), also known as the Old Indian Boundary Line. The site is about 3 miles north of the village of Chesterville. Route 314 was formerly known as the Johnstown-New Haven State Road or the Chesterville-Shelby Road.

Yankee Street Presbyterian Cemetery lies in the west part of the same parcel, a short way from the highway. A Morrow County road, now No. 14, intersects Route 314 slightly to the northeast of the cemetery. Road 14 is sometimes marked Mt. Gilead-Fredericktown Road or Fredericktown

& Pulaskiville Road. Just south of the cemetery on this site, the North Branch of the Kokosing River flows under the highway generally eastward and southward, eventually into the North Branch Kokosing River Lake on Waterford Road in Knox County.

Heading eastward from Route 314, Morrow County Road 14 soon crosses into Knox County and is known as Yankee Street or County Road 371. For much of its Knox County course, it overlies the Greenville Treaty Line, running mostly east and slightly north. Yankee Street passes through the village of Batemantown at the crossing of Waterford Road, and then Yankee Street becomes Knox County Road 55 as it reaches the larger village of Ankenytown northeast of Fredericktown.

### **Supporting Information**

See Appendix A for more information on the land history of Old Harmony Presbyterian Church. Appendix B shows a rough, unverified timeline of Old Harmony and other related churches nearby, and Appendixes C and D list further information on these and other churches named in the record book. Appendix E compares the contents of this record book with information in the 1880 Morrow County History.

The editor did not do extensive genealogical research to sort out, untangle, and identify the approximately 370 unique names in the record book. Appendixes F, G, and H contain small studies of some people named in the record book. Other biographical notes or guesses appear throughout this transcript. Appendixes I, J, and K are indexes or name lists for quick reference.

Editor's Note:

American Presbyterian Church Book of Discipline, Chapter 4, Of Actual Process, Section II:

“There are two modes in which an offense may be brought before a judicatory: either by an individual or individuals, who appear as accusers and undertake to substantiate the charge, or by common fame.”

Section III: “In the former case, process must be pursued in the name of the accuser or accusers. In the latter, there is no need of naming any person as the accuser; common fame is the accuser. Yet a general rumor may be raised by the rashness, censoriousness, or malice of one or more individuals. When this appears to have been the case, such individuals ought to be censured, in proportion to the degree of criminality which appears attached to their conduct.”

  - Thomas Axtell (1780–1853)
  - Thomas M. Axtell (unknown–1844).

2. The “L. Hardenbrook” listed near the top may have been Lodwick Hardenbrook (1755–1845), interred at Old Mount Gilead Presbyterian Cemetery. See the corresponding entry after the Morrisons on the full member list below. According to FindAGrave:

Lodwick Hardenbrook was born on 16 April 1755, in Somerset County, New Jersey, the son of Lodowyck Hardenbroeck (1723 NJ–1779 Somerset Co, NJ) and Catherine Bodine (1720 NJ–1789 Somerset Co, NJ). He married Elizabeth Waldron on 15 April 1781, in Somerset County, New Jersey. They were the parents of 8 sons and 3 daughters. He died on 14 February 1845, in Mount Gilead, Morrow County, Ohio, at the age of 89, and was buried in Mount Gilead, Gilead Township, Morrow County, Ohio [in the Old Mount Gilead Presbyterian Cemetery].

According to the 1911 Morrow County History, “The first settler near Mt Gilead was Lewis Hardenbrook in 1817, and his brother Ralph came soon after and they built a cabin on the one hundred and sixty acres of land immediately south of Mt. Gilead...These two men cleared off this farm. Their father, **Lodwick Hardenbrook**, a soldier of the Revolution, had entered [i.e., acquired title to] this land from the United States. It is the southeast quarter of section 2, township 13, range 21. It would have been in Marion County at the time. Lodwick Hardenbrook sold this farm, in 1823, to Nathan Nickols, Jr., of Loudoun county, Virginia, for \$1,100, and conveyed it to him by deed bearing date February 24, 1826; acknowledged before Isaac Blazer, justice peace, of Marion county, Ohio, with Joseph Worsley and Abraham Hardenbrook as witnesses. **Lodwick Hardenbrook** died February 14, 1845, aged nearly ninety years, and his grave is in the old cemetery at Mt. Gilead.” (A. J. Baughman and Robert F. Bartlett, History of Morrow County, Ohio, vol. 1. Chicago: The Lewis Publishing Company, 1911, p. 236.)

3. The list of members dismissed has
  - Elizabeth Miller (joined O.H. presumably June 1827 or 1828)
  - Elizabeth Miller Sen (joined July 1829)
  - Elizabeth Miller Jun (joined July 1829).
4. Morrison’s farm, the site of Center Presbyterian Church, included what was then the crossroads of present Morrow County Road 110 (Cardington-Williamsport Road) and County Road 104 (Morrison Road). The site is about 5 miles northwest of the Old Harmony Church site, and is in the vicinity of the present Hidden Lakes campground and Bryn Zion Baptist Church. Descendants of the Morrisons still own lands in the area. See Appendix D for a discussion of a report on Early Churches in Morrow County, and some possibly erroneous accounts on where the Center Church was. The 1857 Franklin Township Atlas shows a “J. Morrison” owning a parcel of about 168 acres mostly south and east of the same intersection. The map could reflect a simple clerical error, swapping a J for a T.

Alternatively, FindAGrave says that Thomas Morrison (1798–1873) and his wife Mary Morrison (1799?–1883), both interred nearby at Bryn Zion Cemetery, had four sons:

- Robert
- Henry Jennings
- James Leslie
- Thomas P.

So if the 168-acre parcel shown on the 1857 Atlas is the same place, then the farm could still have been owned by Thomas, or it could have passed from Thomas and Mary to James or to some other J. Morrison. Best guess, not having checked the land records, is that Thomas still owned the place in 1857.

Sidelights: The website [ohioghosttowns.org](http://ohioghosttowns.org) lists Florida Grove as a village founded in the early 1820s at the same place, the intersection of Roads 110 and 104, by Rev. George Vaneman, Plumb Suttleff, and Samuel Hardenbrook. The web site says the prospective village had reverted back to farmland by the mid-1800s. If pioneer developers had wanted to build a village, then constructing a church would have been a natural place to start.

FindAGrave has Rev. George Vaneman (1786–1877) as interred at Maple Grove Cemetery in Findlay, Hancock County, in northwest Ohio. He had a daughter named Sarah Vaneman (see OHMembers\_02, RIGHT).

The 1857 Atlas shows Road 104 continuing about 1 mile southeastward from Road 110, and connecting with the Pulaskiville Road (present Road 109). That segment of Road 104 was abandoned and no longer exists as a public highway.

Editor's Note:

Through contact with fellow genealogist Charlotte Chipps, I learned that this was probably Sarah Ross Chipps (1757–1850), the wife of Morris Tammage Chipps, Sr. (1750–1818). FindAGrave gives Sarah's middle initial as "B" but her middle name as "Denton." Morris Sr. died in New Jersey, and Sarah arrived in Ohio at some point before 1837. Her daughter Deborah arrived in Ohio by 1819. Deborah was married to Jeremiah Coleman. Sarah's son William moved to what would later become Morrow County around 1836. These Colemans and Sarah Chips/Chipps are all buried in Maple Grove Cemetery in Chesterville. A branch named Chips/Chipps were also early settlers along the Kokosing River (creek) in the neighboring corner of Harmony Township to the southwest of Franklin. Harmony Township Road 122 is named Chipps Road.

### Editor's Notes:

1. The 1897 death for Stephen Corwin appears to be the last date in this record book. It suggests that someone kept and used the record book long after Harmony Presbyterian Church ceased to be active. This record book has very few notations dated after 1846. See Appendix F for a comparison of burials at what is now known as Yankee Street Presbyterian Cemetery, as documented on the FindAGrave website, and the names of those in that cemetery and also associated with Old Harmony Presbyterian Church.
2. This David Shaw is believed to have been a prominent landowner and justice of the peace, son of Samuel Shaw, the first European settler of Franklin Township. A David Shaw was listed as head of a household in the 1840 U.S. Census for Franklin Township, then in Knox County, Ohio. The U.S. Census for 1850 in Franklin Township lists David Shaw (born c. 1793/4; age 56) as head of household, with Elizabeth Shaw (46), [Newton?] (25), Emily (22), Asher (16), Albert (15), Clarinda (10), and Ann (5).

David Shaw (b. 1793/4) married Elizabeth Hardenbrook on 3 June 1824 in Knox County, Ohio. David's name appears on Knox County, Ohio, tax records for 1827, 1828, 1829, 1830, and 1838. Three of the children of David Shaw and Elizabeth Hardenbrook, have death certificates, namely Newton Shaw (1827–1882); Emily Fredericks (1829–1914); and Clarissa Ann Burns (1845–1927). The father is believed to be the same David Shaw that is interred at Yankee Street (Pioneer) Presbyterian Cemetery.

Elizabeth Shaw is listed later in this transcript as a member of O.H. Church. Elizabeth Hardenbrook Shaw (1804–1886) was the wife of David Shaw (b. 1793/4). Elizabeth is interred at Rivercliff Cemetery, Mount Gilead, Ohio, in Section 10A, near the graves of Dr. H.H. Shaw and Catherine Shaw. The 1880 Morrow County History has a biography of Elizabeth Hardenbrook Shaw's son Henry H. Shaw (1825–1886), who was a physician and had served in the Civil War. H.H. Shaw's wife was C. Amanda Chamberlain [pg. 554].

Find A Grave says that Elizabeth was born in Jefferson County, Ohio, on 19 April 1804, and died in Morrow County at age 82 years, 2 months, 21 days, on 6 July 1886. The same source lists her children as Henry Harrison Shaw (1825–1886); Emily Shaw Fredericks (1828–1914); Asher Shaw (1833–1894); Albert Shaw (1835–1858); Clarinda J. Shaw (1840–1853); and Clarissa Ann Shaw Burns (1845–1927).

The 1880 Morrow County History also has a biography of Newton Shaw, which says that his grandfather, Samuel Shaw, purchased 600 acres of land in Franklin Township in 1808 and arrived there in 1809, building the first cabin in the township (pg. 795). This is near the present site of the intersection or jog of County Road 98 at County Road 121 northwest of Chesterville, about where Road 121 now has a bridge to cross over present Interstate Highway 71. The same history says that the parents of Elizabeth Hardenbrook Shaw were Lewis Hardenbrook and Elizabeth Waldron, who settled in Franklin Township in 1816 and raised a family of 11 children.

## Appendix A. Land History of Old Harmony/Yankee Street (?) Presbyterian Church

*Franklin Township, Morrow County (formerly part of Knox County), Ohio*

The current site of the Yankee Presbyterian Cemetery is believed to be the same location as that of the Old Harmony Presbyterian Church and cemetery. No proof; only speculation. Until the formation of Morrow County in 1848, Franklin Township was part of Knox County.

[PERSONAL ASIDE: In an ideal world, there would be a clean, unbroken chain of title backward from the present day to the original government land grants or sales, identifying all of the sequential buyers and sellers (grantees and grantors). And in all of those title deeds, all of the legal descriptions would have

- Clear places of beginning with reference to a landmark or another fixed point such as a section or lot corner
- Three or more clear bounds with compass bearings and distances that, when taken together, make sense and enclose each parcel conveyed
- Accurate acreage values for the parcel(s) conveyed.

But that is asking a lot, and several county recorders have told me that 19<sup>th</sup>-century churches, cemeteries, and schools are notorious in not always having their lands exactly documented. This report shows what I found in working on this Old Harmony site, in both Knox and Morrow Counties. Maybe some better researcher will find information I missed or can correct any errors.]

The Greenville Treaty Line divides two of the several land surveys made in the Northwest Territory, around the time of Ohio statehood. The lands south and east of the line in the region of interest are part of the United States Military Lands or Military District, and the lands north and west of the line are part of Congress Lands [North of the Old Seven Ranges]. Likewise, the Old Harmony Presbyterian Church/Cemetery (Yankee Street Presbyterian) site is itself divided by the treaty line.

The next section lists the chain of title from oldest to most recent, as best as can be determined. Names in **boldface** match those in the Old Harmony record book.

### **Military Lands South of the Treaty Line**

#### **U.S. Government to Campbell, 1802**

The southern portion of the church site lies in Aliquot Lot 19, Section or Quarter-Township 4, Survey Township 8 North, and Range 15 West, USMD. It was granted to a former colonel in the U.S. Army, as compensation for his military service.

According to the Bureau of Land Management, General Land Office, on 21 December 1802, before Ohio achieved statehood, the U.S. government granted about 500 acres of land in this vicinity and south of the treaty line to Colonel Donald Campbell. The patentee/warrantee

received five contiguous lots of land enumerated as Lots 19, 20, 21, 28, and 29 running along or near the site of the present north-south state highway (Route 314).

The original Franklin Township field notes and maps from an 1807 survey by Joseph Vance show Lot 19 as containing 140.53 acres. Rectangular Lots 20, 21, 28, and 29 were between 102 and 103 acres each. In the USMD survey system, each such lot was to be one-sixth of a square mile, or about 106 acres. Lot 19 was irregularly shaped, with the diagonal of the treaty line forming its north side; in consequence, that one lot ended up being much larger than any of the other four. It is not known why the grant was made 5 years before the Vance survey.

As noted, this was a military land grant following the American Revolution. The GLO document identifier for this grant is OH 2110\_\_\_\_.037.

No deed could readily be found showing when or to whom Col. Campbell or his heirs conveyed Lot 19 to other owners.

The Old Harmony record book lists three Campbells: Jane Campbell Axtell, Sarah Campbell Jackson, and William T. Campbell. William is assumed to be the William Teitsworth Campbell (1798–1888) interred nearby in Pulaskiville.

A Jane Axtell (d. 1850) is on FindAGrave as interred at Yankee Street Cemetery. Likewise, a Janet or Jane Campbell Axtell (1796–1863) is on FindAGrave as interred at Yankee Street Cemetery. No connection from any of these Campbells to the original grantee Colonel Donald Campbell could be identified.

### **Stanbery to Smith, 1810**

At the Knox County Recorder, Book B, page 126 shows a deed conveying a one-half interest in 500 acres from Jonas Stanbery/Stanberry of New York City to Samuel H. Smith of Knox County for \$170. The deed grants one equal undivided moiety or half part of 500 acres being Lots 19, 20, 21, 28, and 29 in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of the 8<sup>th</sup> Township of the 15<sup>th</sup> Range in the U.S. Military Tract. The deed was signed on 20 November 1810 and recorded on 10 December 1810.

The deeds showing if, when, or from whom Stanbery acquired the property, or when and how Smith acquired the other half-interest, have not been found.

### **Smith to Corwin, 1813**

At the Knox County Recorder, Book B, page 390 shows a deed conveying 500 acres from Samuel H. Smith of Morris Township, Knox County, to **Benjamin Corwin** of the same place. The price was \$1,000. The deed was signed on 26 February 1813 and recorded on 28 March 1813. The land was all of lots 19, 20, 21, 28, and 29 in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of the 8<sup>th</sup> Township in the 15<sup>th</sup> Range of the U.S. Military District. The deed was witnessed by Isaac Sutton and Benj. Barney.

## **Corwin to Strong, 1814**

At the Knox County Recorder, Book C, page 86 shows a deed conveying the east end of Lot 19 from **Benjamin and Mary Corwin** to Jane Strong. All were of Knox County. This is not the land of the Old Harmony Presbyterian Church, but it may help define the location of the church.

The land was described only as 50 acres off the east end of Lot 19 in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of the 8<sup>th</sup> Township of the 15<sup>th</sup> Range, USMD. The deed says that the land conveyed was adjoining Lot 18, which lies to the south of Lot 19. The legal description does not give a starting point, nor any compass bearings nor lengths of any of the boundaries of the parcel conveyed. It may be that the western line of Lot 18 provides a point of reference as to the western line of the 50 acres conveyed out of Lot 19 in this deed. The selling price was \$150. The deed was signed on 23 April 1814 and recorded on 6 October 1814. It was witnessed by Abner Ayres and **Darius Strong**.

Assuming that Lot 19 covered about 140 acres, based on the original 1807 survey, minus the 50 acres in the Strong transaction and about 1 more acre in the Presbyterian Church transaction below, it is not known when or to whom the Corwins conveyed the remaining approximately 90 acres of Lot 19. No such conveyance could be found in the Knox County records.

## **Corwin to Church Trustees, 1835 (south of treaty line)**

In the Knox County, Ohio, Recorder's office, Volume O, page 58 documents a deed from **Benjamin and Mary Corwin**, husband and wife, to the "trustees of the Presbyterian Church and Congregation of Harmony" signed the same day as a deed from Hyler for lands north of the GTL (see Knox O:56 below), on 14 July 1835. Interestingly, the Corwin deed lists three trustees, namely **Thomas Axtell**, **Samuel Ely Sr.**, and **Charles Levering**, as having paid the grantor \$10. However, the grantees are three different trustees, namely **Richard Struble**, **Nathaniel Henderson**, and **Thomas Kennedy**. Unlike the Hyler "cemetery" deed below, this Corwin deed does not impose any conditions or restrictions on the grantees for their use of the land.

The land is in Lot 19, Range 15, Township 8, Section 4 of the U.S. Military District. The legal description is not perfectly clear, but it appears to depict an irregular triangle that touches or fronts the present Route 314, and has one side of length 13 rods + 1 link and a second side of 26 rods + 7 links. The length of the third side is not given in the deed, but using the known compass bearings and lengths for the first two sides, the third side may have been about 29 rods. If these distances are correct, then the triangle may have enclosed about 1.07 acres.

The deed was witnessed by Washington Strong and Enos Miles, the latter also serving as notary and Justice of the Peace. Note the spelling variation in the surname Strang/Strong.

## **Congress Lands North of the Treaty Line**

The northern portion of the cemetery and church site lies in Section 18, Survey Township 18 North, and Range 19 West, being part of the Congress Lands, and was first sold or granted in a private (not military-related) sale transaction.

### **U.S. Government to Axtell, 1818**

The corresponding Old Harmony lands north of the treaty line were sold on 25 November 1818 by the U.S. Government to **Thomas Axtell** of Knox County, Ohio. The parcel conveyed was all of the irregularly shaped Section 18. The acreage is not noted on the BLM GLO records. The GLO document identifier is CV-0040-333. The original Franklin Township field notes and maps from the 1807 survey by Maxfield Ludlow show Section 18 as containing 146.02 acres.

### **Axtell to Strong, 1823**

In the Knox County Recorder's office, Book E, page 530 shows a deed from **Thomas Axtell** of Knox County to Washington Strong of Knox County. The selling price was \$34.11 for 14 acres + 7 rods, described as part of Section 18, Township 18, Range 19. The land appears to have been in the eastern portion of Section 18, with the treaty line as its south boundary. The eastern line was about 9 rods, the northern line was about 116 rods, and the western line was about 29 rods. The length of the southern line along the treaty line is not given in the legal description. The description seems to conflict with the original survey plat, which lists the eastern border of Section 18 as a very short 2.5 rods. Also, the 14-acre parcel conveyed here does not seem to match a parcel with one side measuring 100 rods, which is about one-third of a mile. Either the land conveyed was really 114 acres, or there are some other error(s) in the legal description needed to locate the land precisely. The deed was signed on 12 December 1823 and recorded on 31 December 1823. It was witnessed by William Van Buskirk and **Joseph Trembly**.

### **Axtell to Hyler, 1830 (not found)**

The deed below (Knox O:56) references a previous deed from **Thomas and Jane Axtell** to **James Hyler** as having been dated 8 September 1830. That deed could not be found in the Knox County Recorder's office.

### **Hyler to Trustees, 1835 (north of treaty line)**

In the Knox County, Ohio, Recorder's office, Volume or Book O, page 56 documents a deed from **James and Anna Hyler**, husband and wife, to the trustees of the "Presbyterian Harmony society (or congregation)" signed 14 July 1835 and duly recorded on 21 July 1835. The grantees are the trustees identified as **Richard D. Struble, Nathaniel Henderson, Thomas Kennedy**, and their successors in office. The deed cites "the necessity of having public burying places in conformity to our present State of improved society" and the land is being granted for "the express purpose of a place of interment or burying ground for all classes and denominations of Christians and others." See Knox O:58 above.

The land is in Range 19, Township 18, Section 18, and cites the adjacent lands of Washington Strang (Strong). Contrary to customary practice, this deed does not give the acreage or area conveyed. The legal description seems to depict an irregular quadrilateral with sides of length 5 perches (rods), 6.5 perches, 8.6 perches, and 9 perches. The last boundary line coincides with the treaty line.

This deed cites one precedent, namely a deed or indenture dated 8 September 1830 from **Thomas and Jane Axtell**, conveying the land to **James Hyler**. The 1830 deed could not be found, as noted above. The 1835 deed was witnessed by **Thomas M. Axtell** and Enos Miles.

### **Axtell to Robinson, 1836**

In the Knox County Recorder's office, Book O, page 591 shows a deed from **Thomas and Jane Axtell** of Knox County to Edmond Robinson of Knox County. The selling price was \$1,240. This was not the Old Harmony church site. The land was the west part of Section 18, Township 18, Range 19 of lands for sale at Wooster, containing 80 acres out of the 146 acres in Section 18. The deed was signed on 25 January 1836 and recorded on 3 February 1836. It was witnessed by H.W. Strong and Dennis Wright.

### **Combined Cemetery/Church Lands North and South of Treaty Line**

#### **Trustees of Marion Presbytery to Trustees of Franklin Township, 1892**

In the Morrow County, Ohio, Recorder's office, Deeds Volume 47, page 21 documents a deed from the Trustees of the Marion Presbytery to the Trustees of Franklin Township. This deed was the result of a vote of the Marion Presbytery on 13 April 1892. The selling price was \$1. The deed was signed on 11 August 1892 and was recorded on 22 October 1892. As grantors or sellers, the three Presbytery Trustees were J.W. Robinson (Union County), B.L. Longwell (Delaware County), and J.H. Pollock (Morrow County). As grantees or buyers, the three Franklin Township Trustees were Salathiel Boner, Ephraim Zohnan, and Noah L. Barnes.

The legal description of the parcel conveyed is somewhat confusing, and is missing certain distances between corners, but the parcel consisted of 2 acres more or less. As an example, one part of the legal description reads that the border of the parcel runs "thence northeasterly along the boundary line [GTL] to West line of the Cemetery, thence North 15° East about 9 rods to the Northwest Corner of the Cemetery." This description presumes that everyone knows and agrees where the west line and the northwest corner of the cemetery are.

This 1892 deed notes that the cemetery was composed of three parcels and was obtained from different persons:

- The part south of the GTL was formerly owned by **Benjamin Corwin**
- The part north of the GTL was formerly owned by **James Hyler** and Washington Strong.

Witnesses or notaries to this deed were R.L. Woodburn, A.W. Shields, Benjamin Olds, and Thomas P. Morrison.<sup>2</sup> In an addition at the end of the deed, the three named Township Trustees formally signed to acknowledge their obligation to trust and care for the cemetery.

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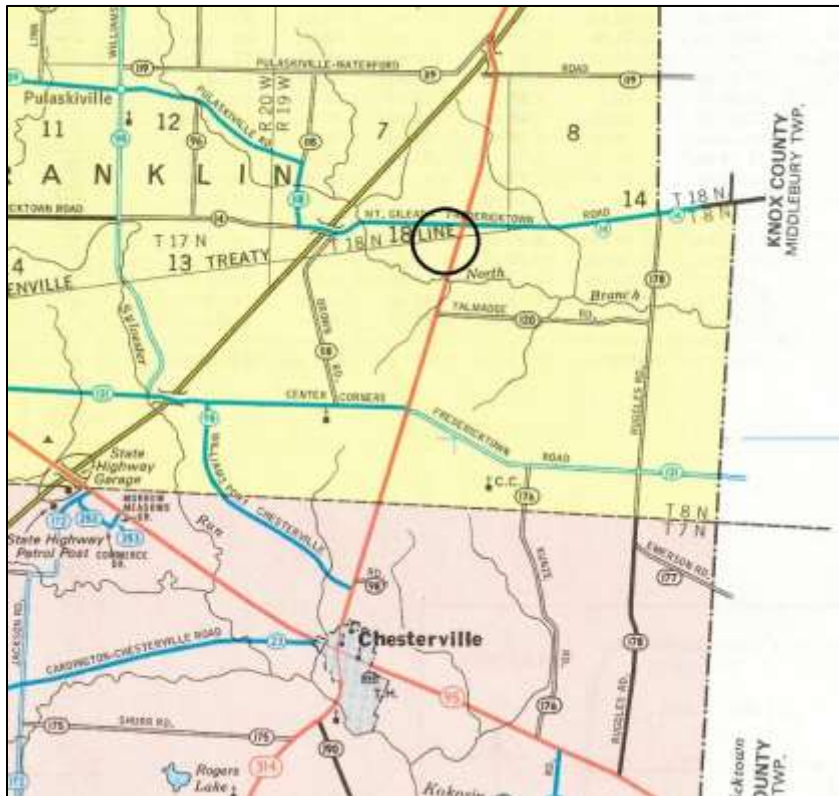

## Records of Yankee Street Cemetery Lands as of 2024

The current parcel containing the cemetery appears on the Morrow County Engineer's website as having been last conveyed in 1892 according to Deeds Volume 47, page 21 (see above). The tax map is on page F-5, and the survey showing the parcel is in Volume 03, page 066. The parcel covers 1.2 acres and carries the identifying number F14-501-00-113-00. It is unknown how the site changed from covering 2 acres in 1892 to covering 1.2 acres today.

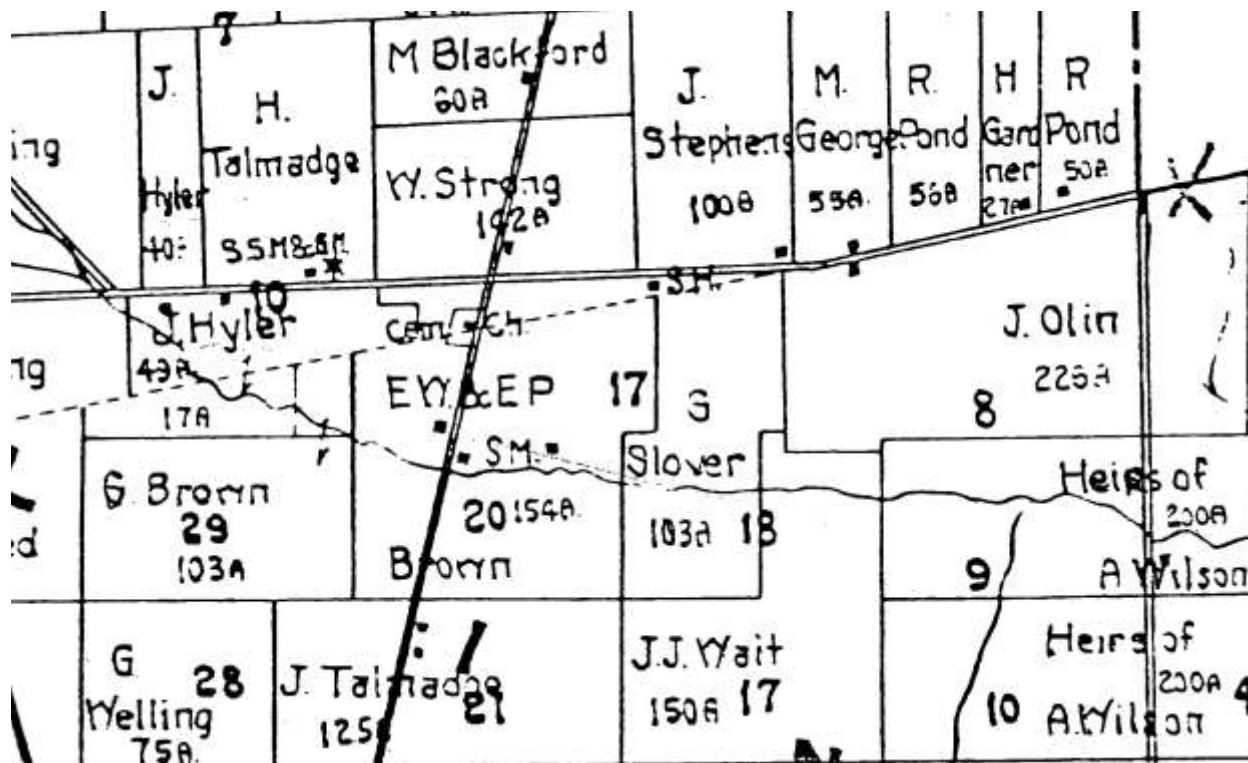

Larger view of the Morrow/Knox County regions surrounding Old Harmony site.

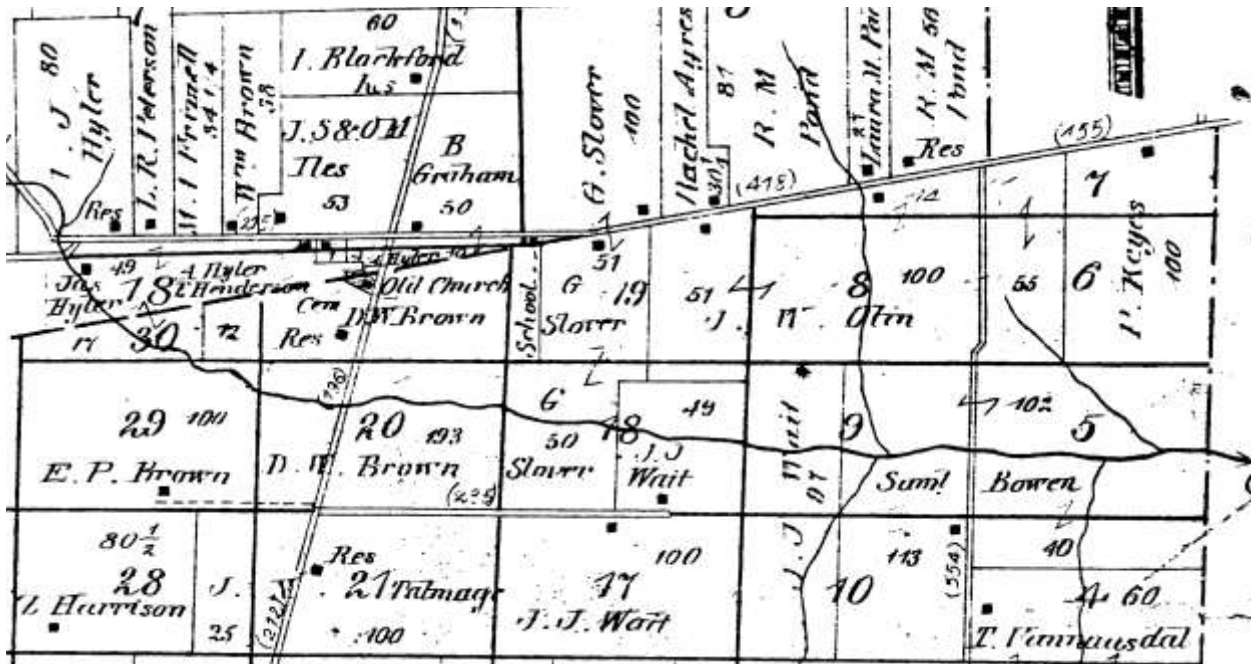

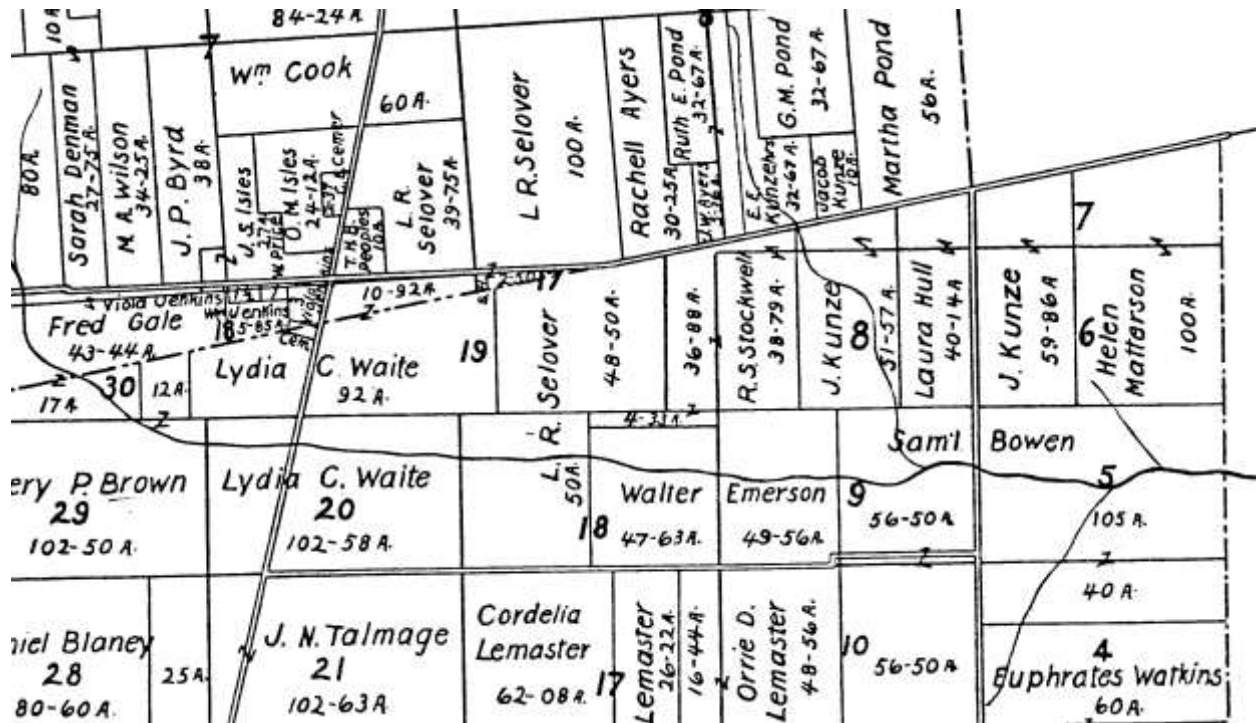

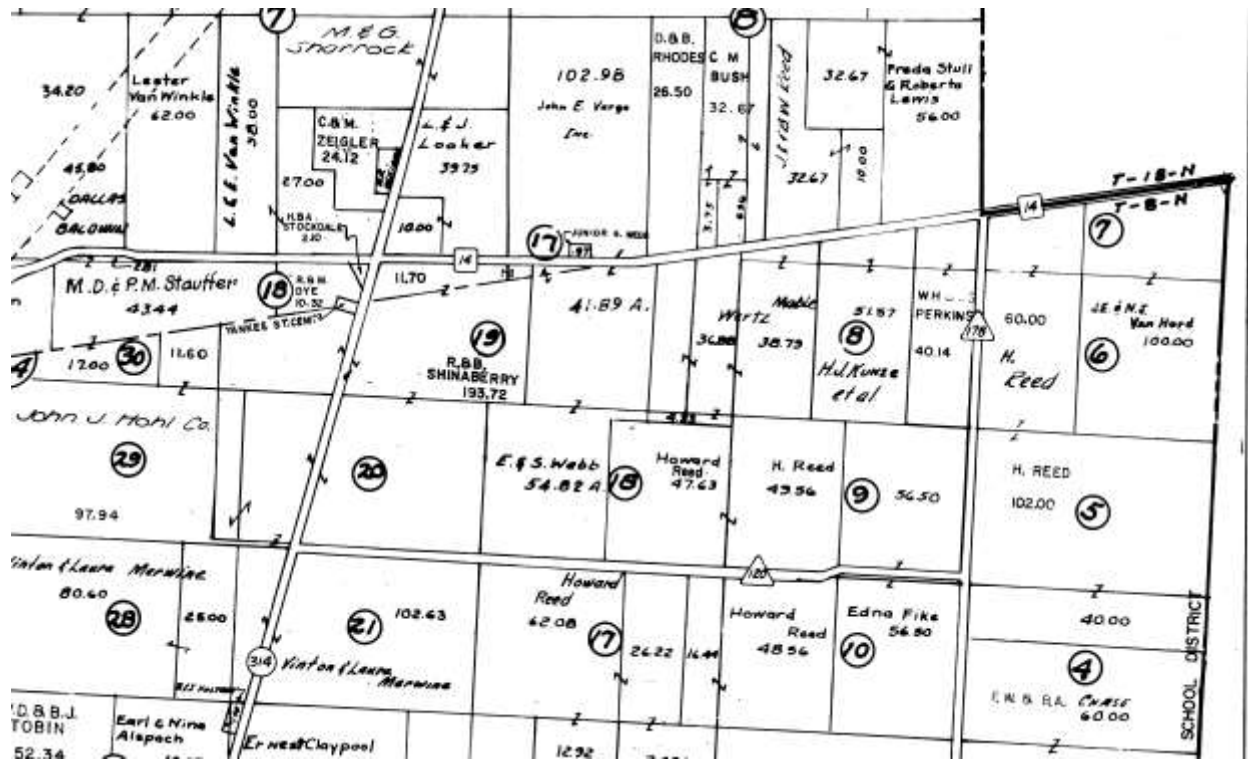

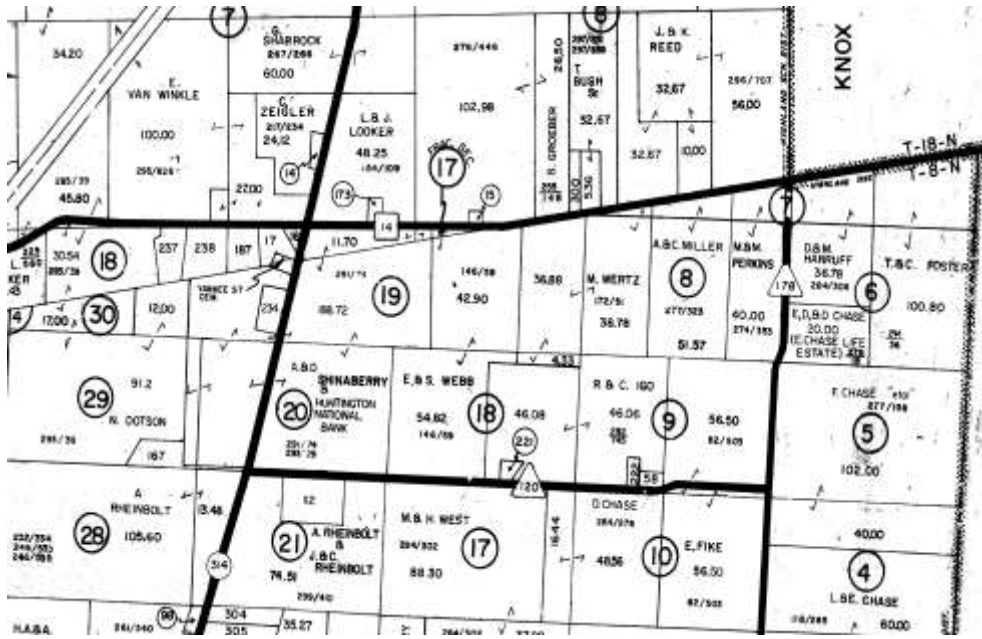

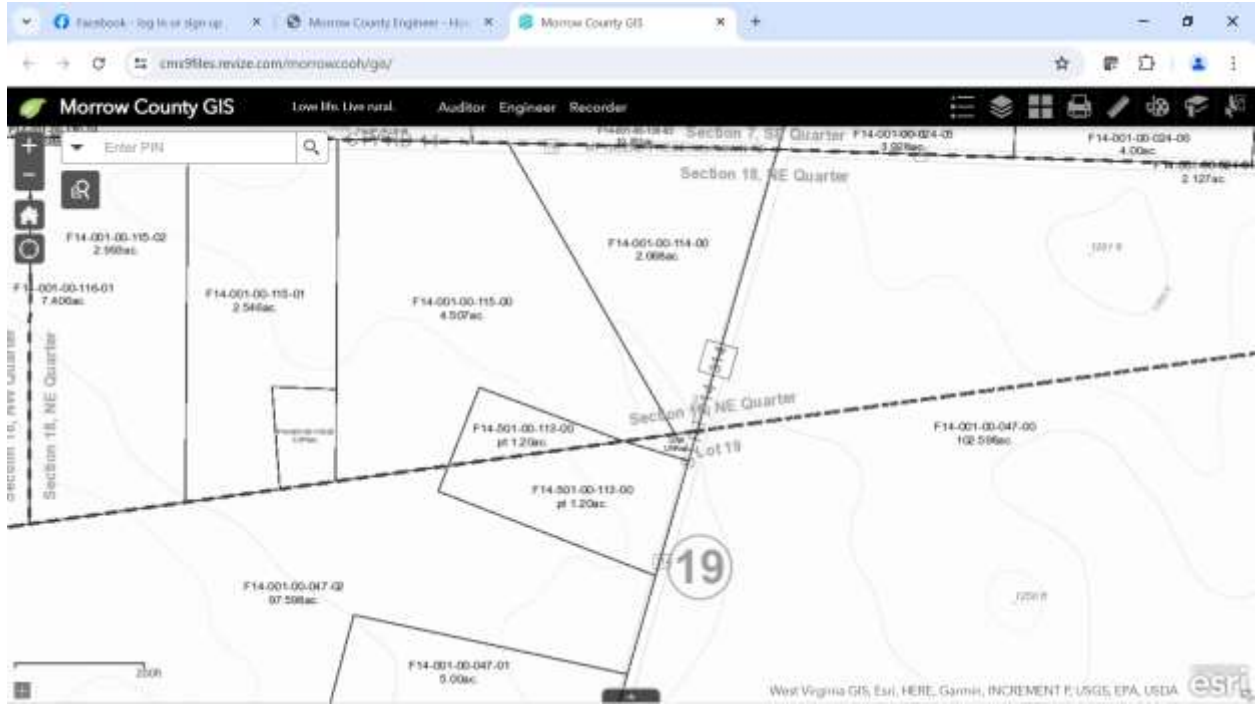

**Appendix D. Comparison of Information from “Morrow County’s Earliest Churches” and the Old Harmony Record Book**

The “Earliest Churches” (EC) report was written by Cecil Leon Graham (1905–1993). Published February 2003 by the Cecil Graham Family and the Morrow County [Ohio] Genealogical Society.

This EC report lists among the old churches of Franklin Township:

- Center Presbyterian
- Yankee Street (Blue) Presbyterian.

Likewise, the book lists among the old churches of Harmony Township:

- Harmony Presbyterian.

With all due respect, there is reason to doubt some of the information in the EC report. Below is the information from the book, accompanied by updates, theories, and commentary.

<b>Morrow County’s Earliest Churches</b>	<b>Editorial Notes and Commentary</b>
<p><b>Center Presbyterian Church (Franklin Township No. 35)</b></p> <p>This church was organized by <b>Rev. Wm. Matthews</b> on December 29, 1826 and erected a log church in 1831. It was located in the Northwest part of Franklin Township on the Mansfield and Delaware Road, 3 miles East of Mt. Gilead on Rt. 95.</p> <p>This served until 1839 when a frame structure was erected and the congregation split about equal from 51 members. 26 members went with their pastor, Rev. Henry Shedd to Mt. Gilead. The remaining 25 stayed until 1848 when they united with the Mt. Gilead Old School and abandoned their building which was rebuilt in 1844.</p> <p>This building was sold to Samuel Peoples in 1848 and moved to Mt. Gilead and fitted for a dwelling.</p>	<p>The “Mansfield and Delaware Road” would seem to fit present U.S Route 42, although it is possible that Mr. Graham refers to present Morrow County Road 110, which does in fact connect with US 42 at two points: south of Mount Gilead near Quakerdom and north of Mount Gilead at Bryn Zion.</p> <p>The present Ohio Route 95 does not go to either Mansfield or Delaware. What to make of this? Mr. Graham and/or his informants may have mixed up Center, Yankee, and Harmony Presbyterian churches or their respective locations with other churches or schools at those places. Or it may be that some old churches, now lost and forgotten, did exist at the sites on Route 95 at Road 110 or at on Route 95 at Road 20, but such a church does not appear on any old maps or on any known lists of the oldest cemeteries.

According to Wikipedia, the split between Old School and New School Presbyterians did indeed occur in 1837, with the Old School being more conservative and opposed to revivalism, whereas the New School followed John Edwards and others and embraced revivalism.

The “Old” in the name “Old Harmony” may have referred to the “Old School” identity or character of this Presbyterian congregation. The term may not have been in contrast with some newer Presbyterian church in the vicinity, nor was the name likely intended to distinguish Old Harmony Presbyterian from the much later Harmony (Wildcat) Baptist Church and Harmony Methodist Episcopal Church (founded in the 1840s), both of which were about 6 miles away in neighboring Harmony Township.

## Appendix E. Relevant Excerpts from 1880 “History of Morrow County and Ohio”

*by William Henry Perrin and J.H. Battle, Chicago: O.L. Baskin & Co.*

Page 371, Chester Township [Presumably this refers to the founding of Chesterville Presbyterian Church, in the village about 3 miles south of Old Harmony/Yankee Street Presbyterian.]

Underlined: persons named in the Old Harmony Presbyterian record book and also in the 1880 Morrow County History.

“In 1845, the Presbyterian Church formed a society in this township. Ebenezer Goble, a member of this denomination and an earnest Christian man, desired to have a society formed here, and, though far from wealthy, made such strenuous efforts that he accomplished that end in the year mentioned. On the first page of the sessions record is found the following: ‘At the sessions of the Presbytery of Richland, held in the church of Blooming Grove, April 8 and 9, 1845, a request from sundry members of the Frederick Church, and others living in the vicinity of Chesterville, that a church might be organized in the latter place, was granted, and the Rev. James Scott and Ruling Elder Alexander Menzie, of the Church of Frederick, were appointed a committee to carry into effect the wishes of the petitioners and the resolution of the Presbytery.’ On May 15, 1845, the following persons presented certificates of dismission from the different churches near by:

The next movement after the organization of a society was for the erection of a church building. Mr. Goble, though not possessed of great means, was indefatigable in his efforts, and his house became the place for holding the meetings for furthering the interests of the church. On February 1, 1845, at a meeting at his house, himself, with H. Struble [is this a typographical error for R. Struble?], Israel Green, William Beemer and Julius W. Fox, were appointed a building committee, and in that year, a lot was purchased for \$35, and a place of worship erected upon it that cost \$319 for the woodwork, and \$95 for the masonry for it. The Rev. John Elliott presided over the church as a missionary at first, but, **in 1846, the Rev. F.A. Shearer divided his time between the Chesterville Church and the Harmony Church in Franklin.** The present pastor is Rev T.J. McClelland, a graduate of Alleghany City College. The membership now reaches forty persons. The church has had an arduous struggle for existence from the first, but it has gradually got on to a securer basis and is now in a fair growing condition.”

Editor’s Notes:

1. “Dimiss” is an archaic form of “dismiss.” The Oxford English Dictionary last recorded “dimiss” in the late 1700s, but the term obviously survived, unless this is a typographical error in the 1880 Morrow County History. The spelling “dimiss” does appear in some website accounts of Presbyterian Church history.
2. Fredericktown is a village in northwest Knox County, near Chesterville. Martinsburg is a village in Knox County, about as far southeast of the county seat in Mount Vernon as Fredericktown is to the northwest. Amity is a village several miles northeast of Mount Vernon, also in Knox County. The only Strongsville in Ohio is near Cleveland, about 100 miles to the north and east of Knox County. There is a United Church of Christ in Strongsville, which was formerly a Congregational Church, and was founded in 1817.

## Appendix G. Solving Name and Spelling Puzzles

Names in boldface are found in the Old Harmony record book.

**Beemer/Beamer:** FindAGrave has a record of a **W.N. Beemer** [1822–1887; ID 68410346], interred at Maple Grove in Chesterville, Ohio. This record shows his younger siblings as

- **Martha Jane Beemer** Millard (1837–1931)
- **Julia A. Beemer** Bailey (1839–1909)
- **Hannah Eliza Beemer** Bailey (1840–1909)
- Rozella Beemer Kron (1843–1911)
- Edward Allen Beemer (1848–1931)
- Mary Amanda Beemer Bates (1856–1935).

Here and elsewhere in this appendix, plausible matches with the Old Harmony Presbyterian record book are shown in boldface. A Rozilla Beemer (born c. 1844) and an Edward A. Beemer (born c. 1848) are also attested in this family group in Chester Township in 1850.

**Hustick:** This surname does not appear in the 1880 Morrow County History, but the similar name “Ustick” does. A Henry Ustick is notable in that history:

- Henry Ustick (pg. 291, built a sawmill on the Whetstone Creek in Cardington Township; pg. 292, built a house in Whetstone, later renamed Mount Gilead; pg. 293, Justice of the Peace in Gilead Township, Colonel of the militia, County Commissioner, and Associate Judge of the county; pg. 301 and 302, hosting first Presbyterian meetings).
- Postmaster General Ustick (pg. 306).

**Karne/Carney/Carna:** The name “Sarah Karne” was selected on the basis of a grave marker with that name (1767–1840; ID 100942778) in the Yankee Street Presbyterian Cemetery. However, the engravers of markers have been known to make errors.

**Pharis/Faris:** FindAGrave has a record of a **William Pharis** (1789–1881; ID 152667350), interred at Chesterville Presbyterian Cemetery in Chesterville, Ohio. The record shows his wife as **Hannah McNay Pharis** and their children as:

- Sarah Pharis Jarvis (1819–1896)
- Samuel McNay Pharis (1820–1877)
- William Alfred Pharis (1825–1905)
- **Julia Ann Pharis** Lhamon (1830–1921).

**Shur/Shurr:** FindAGrave has a record of a **Jacob Shur** (1776–1844; ID 66799290), marker currently at Maple Grove Cemetery in Chesterville, Ohio. The record shows that this marker is a cenotaph, having been moved to Maple Grove from Chesterville Methodist Cemetery in the 1960s. The record shows Mr. Shur’s wife as **Margaret Porter Shur** (1785–1876).

**Sipe/Sipes/Sype:** FindAGrave has a record of a **Christopher Sipe [Sr.]** (1878–1873; ID 26378361), interred at North Fork [Owl Creek] Cemetery, Chesterville, Ohio, in Row 19. His spouse is **Mary Levering Sipe** (1791–1877) and their children are documented as:

**Smiley/Smily:** FindAGrave has a record of a **John Smiley** (1800–1881; ID 66115862), interred at Maple Grove Cemetery, Chesterville, Ohio. His two spouses are **Asenath Corwin Smiley** (1802–1828) and **Sarah Smiley** (1810–1891). John Smiley’s children appear to be as follows:

with Asenath as the mother:

with Sarah as the mother:

**Vanornam; Vanliew:** Several Dutch-looking names are difficult to decipher from the handwriting in the Old Harmony record book. These two are best guesses looking across all related forms and records. Interestingly, one of the founders of Florida Grove, in far western Franklin Township, was named Rev. George Vaneman or Van Eman, according to an Ohio Ghost Towns website. And FindAGrave says this George had a daughter named Sarah. This surname is suspiciously similar to what I am rendering as “Vanornam.”

Vanornam, and variants such as Van Arnhem, Van Ornam, Van Ornum, and Van Orman etc., are documented as American surnames. Likewise Vanlue, which coincidentally is the name of a town in northwest Ohio, in Hancock County near Ohio Route 15.

These numbers are probably incomplete and misleading. They appear not to count many members who left. According to the numbers above, the church would have had more than 200 members from 1837 onward, and the O.H. record book itself says that in 1842, there were 66 members in communion.

The notable years were 1826, when the membership quadrupled, and 1836, when it lost probably half or more of its members to Center Presbyterian.

Within the record book, there were an additional 29 members whose place of dismissal (where they left O.H. to join another church) was given, but no year was specified.

Likewise, 11 deaths were documented with dates well after 1846, or with no date, as follows:

This suggests that whichever person(s) curated and kept up the record book, some of them were careful to add death information long after the church had dwindled or closed, even to more than 50 years after the last formal membership record in 1846.

## Appendix K. Index of All Names

In this index, there is one row per instance or occurrence of any name in the record book, so many of the names are repeated. For example, the same name might appear on the list of members dismissed to Center Church, on the list of all members, and in the chronology on the day that person joined the church as well as being a mother or father for one or more baptized children.

Last or Married Name; Birth or Maiden Name, if different; First Name, and Middle Name or Initial are generally verbatim as they appear in the original handwritten record book, or as well as they could be deciphered from the handwriting.

The Best Name column shows the editor's best guess at the full or complete/corrected name, for example when someone has both a maiden and a married name, or two forms of the same name, as in Wm = William.

The "Type" column shows the kind of information or action/role for that person in each instance. Page shows the file name in the digital image files, Side shows left or right side/page of the spread, and Position gives the row or sequence number of that name on that page, to help readers quickly find a name at the top, middle, or bottom of each page in the transcript.
